- Teacher Report: Ms Popic on the French program:
- FSL at Acadia is taught in Grades 3-6
- Each class gets two 45 minute periods a week which has lots of movement, videos and games to learn the language. They play matching games & charades and engage in talking circles. The kid's are taught using the science of reading approach (in french). They study specific sounds in a very specific sequence so that when they encounter these sounds in French words, students are able to read them which gets them more excited to learn the language.
- Friday Feb. 21st they will have a French show called Folklofolie coming into the school to
 put on a show for the kids to immerse them in the language and Culture in Quebec. In April,
 Alliance Francaise is coming to help the students create an art project (either a short video
 or comic book).
